PRE-ANESTHETIC INSTRUCTIONS

The nurse will call 2 days prior to the day of surgery to give you the exact time to be here. We ask that you keep the entire day open on the date of your child's appointment.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

Please arrive on time for your scheduled anesthesia/surgery at the Dental Surgical Center of Medina. At least two doctors will be present at all times while your child is under our care. (Due to the overwhelming demand, failure to show up for your appointment without 48 hours advance notice may result in your child not being rescheduled at our facility for general anesthesia in the future.)

YOUR CHILD SHOULD NOT EAT OR DRINK ANYTHING AFTER MIDNIGHT PRIOR TO THE DAY OF SURGERY. UNLESS IT IS MEDICINES PREVIOUSLY DISCUSSED WITH YOUR ANESTHESIOLOGIST. YOUR CHILD SHOULD NOT HAVE A LARGE MEAL AFTER 9:00 P.M. NIGHT BEFORE THE APPOINTMENT.

IF YOUR CHILD IS TAKING ANY MEDICATIONS, IT IS VERY IMPORTANT TO TELL THE NURSE WHEN HE/SHE CALLS YOU BEFORE YOUR CHILD'S APPOINTMENT.

Your child should not wear contact lenses.

Your child should not wear cosmetics, especially fingernail polish.

Your child should wear old, loose-fitting clothing with short sleeves. **ALSO, PLEASE BRING A COMPLETE CHANGE OF CLOTHING FOR YOUR CHILD, IN CASE OF ACCIDENTS.**

Due to the children who cannot eat or drink anything, we ask that there is **NO FOOD OR DRINKS** in our waiting room when you arrive. We appreciate your cooperation and understanding.

THE PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN MUST BE PRESENT FOR THE START OF THE ANESTHESIA AND BE AVAILABLE FOR THE DURATION OF ANESTHESIA. ARRANGEMENTS SHOULD BE MADE TO CARE FOR YOUR CHILD AT HOME THE REMAINDER OF THE DAY.

A second responsible person should be available so that you may care for your child on the drive home. Please make other arrangements for brothers and sisters so that your attention can be given to your child that is receiving treatment.

These instructions are designed for your child's comfort and protection. A failure to follow any of these instructions may require us to cancel your appointment for that day. Should any other circumstance develop, such as an illness (cold or flu), that would require the postponement of your dental surgery, please notify us at (330) 952-1737.
